- Your organisation name and a brief description of who you are / what you do.
- Some history including what you've achieved in any of the above or in any other area/s.
- Description of this application's project vision/scope/proposal including your contribution.
- Specify the amount of up to \$1000 you are asking for and
- why you feel you should be considered for a funding grant.
